



Vaccination for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children are at increased risk of serious diseases and can get extra vaccines for free through the National Immunisation Program.



6 months to <5 years
every year

- ▶ **Influenza**

Birth

- ▶ Hepatitis B
- ▶ **BCG** – neonates living in high-TB incidence areas in NT, Qld and northern SA (funded by states and territories)

2 months

- ▶ DTPa-hepB-IPV-Hib

4 months

18 months

- ▶ MMRV
- ▶ DTPa
- ▶ Hib
- ▶ **Hepatitis A** – children living in NT, Qld, SA and WA

4–5 years

- ▶ DTPa-IPV
- ▶ **Hepatitis A** – children living in NT, Qld, SA and WA
